1 Edits

Edits refer to 01-007r1. Page and line numbers are displayed in the margin. Absent other instructions, a page and line number or line number range implies all of the indicated text is to be replaced by immediately following text, while a page and line number followed by + (-) indicates that immediately following text is to be inserted after (before) the indicated line. Remarks are noted in the margin, or appear between [and] in the text.

[The sentence is run-on. Editor: “, and” ⇒ “;”.]	3:2
[The colon is improper punctuation, a minor rearrangement of the sentence can change the “different than” to a “different from”, and the comparison should be to Fortran 2000, not Fortran 95. Editor: “: ... Fortran 95” ⇒ “. Therefore some FORTRAN 77 processors may produce an output form different from the output form produced by Fortran 2000 processors”.]	4:21-22
[The split infinitive is easy to repair. Editor: move “automatically” to be after “parser”.]	5:18
[Editor: “We refer” ⇒ “This standard refers” twice.]	7:13,18
