Item 12 of paper 02-138r2 added the above reference to "this module", along with one other simillar reference in this section and two in 14.7. However, the referent for "this" is unclear. Three intrinsic modules are defined in Section 14. One of the references is even in a sentence that begins by specifying two of the three modules, making the referent particularly confusing.

I'll suggest that at least in the above case, this could be fixed just by removing material. It is in a clause introduced by "examples are," which implies that the list is incomplete (and it's implication is correct).
