- (1) Move the general index to be the last annex.
- (2) Integrate the syntax term index into the general index.
- (3) If possible, notes that are continued onto a subsequent page ought to have a continuation indication at the bottom of the page. In a previous version of the macros, this was done by leaving off the bottom line, but an indication such as (cont.) at the bottom of the page is preferred.
- (4) The Editor is authorized to put a BNF cross reference at the end of the BNF summary annex, if such can be developed without undue effort.
