1 **1 Edits**

2 Edits refer to 03-007. Page and line numbers are displayed in the margin. Absent other instructions, a  
3 page and line number or line number range implies all of the indicated text is to be replaced by associated  
4 text, while a page and line number followed by + (-) indicates that associated text is to be inserted after  
5 (before) the indicated line. Remarks are noted in the margin, or appear between [ and ] in the text.

6 [The current words do an extremely poor job of explaining an effect similar to INTENT(IN). Editor: 84:5  
7 Replace “it shall ... change” with “its association shall not be changed except that it may become  
8 undefined if the target is deallocated other than through the pointer (16.4.2.1.3) or if the target becomes  
9 undefined by execution of a RETURN or END statement”. Most of these words were cadged from  
10 [81:15-17].]
