Subject: Issue 273, and other work on passed-object dummy arguments

1 Introduction

At meeting 153, /data thought a constraint was an inappropriate place for a definition, so we moved the definition of passed-object dummy arguments from the constraints in 4.5.1 (at [43:7-10, 43:25-28 and 43:38-42]) to a new section 4.5.1.6. We overlooked that there remained two constraints on page 43 that referred to the passed-object dummy argument, for which the definition is now several pages distant, and forward.

Issue 273 finds the newly-introduced wording in 4.5.1.6 confusing.
