Absent other instructions, a page and line number or line number range implies all of the indicated text is to be replaced by associated text, while a page and line number followed by + (-) indicates that associated text is to be inserted after (before) the indicated line. Remarks are noted in the margin, or appear between [and] in the text. [Since other constraints prevent the ALLOCATABLE, POINTER and OPTIONAL attributes 71:31 from all being specified at once, either the constraint is vacuous or something else is intended.
