Problem with intrisic functions with KIND arguments

- We added KIND arguments to several intrinsic functions, resulting in AINT, ANINT, DINT, DNINT,
- IDNINT, INDEX, LEN and NINT specific functions having KIND arguments. It does not make sense 9
- to be able to pass them as actual arguments. 10
- In those cases where the corresponding generic function has an optional dummy argument named KIND, 298:16+ New¶ 11
- the specific function omits that argument. The special meaning of the KIND argument is fundamentally 12
- a generic concept.
